

BUILDING ADMINISTRATION

The Maggie L. Walker Governor's School Regional School Board, upon recommendation of the Superintendent's Steering Committee, employs a director and assistant principals/coordinators who hold licenses as prescribed by the Board of Education.

In accordance with the Constitution of the Maggie L. Walker Governor's School, Article VI, a director provides instructional leadership in, is responsible for the administration of and supervises the operation and management of the school and property to which he has been assigned, in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Regional School Board and under the supervision of the Superintendent's Steering Committee.

A director may submit recommendations to the Superintendent's Steering Committee and/or the Regional School Board for the appointment, assignment, promotion, transfer and dismissal of all personnel assigned to his supervision.

The director will perform all of these duties and others in accordance with the Constitution of the Maggie L. Walker Governor's School, Article VI.

In evaluating the performance of the director and assistant principals/coordinators, the Superintendent's Steering Committee shall consider the criteria and process set forth in the Guidelines for Uniform Performance Standards and Evaluation Criteria. Those criteria include standards addressing instructional leadership, school climate, human resources management, organizational management, communication and community relations, professionalism and student academic progress.
