DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE

A Disciplinary Committee composed of at least three Regional School Board members, one of whom should be from the student's home division, presides over all cases of student suspensions of more than 10 days up to 364 days. The decision of the committee, if unanimous, is the final decision of the Regional School Board. In non-unanimous decisions, the student has the right to appeal to the full Regional School Board. The Regional School Board shall render a final decision in such cases on the appeal within thirty days of the Committee decision.

The Disciplinary Committee follows the procedures set forth in Policy 8090 Student Suspension/Expulsion.

Membership on the Disciplinary Committee is determined by the Regional School Board.
