

HOMEBOUND INSTRUCTION

Homebound Instruction

The participating school divisions of Maggie L Walker Governor's School shall maintain a program of homebound instruction for students who are confined at home or in a health care facility for periods that would prevent normal school attendance based upon certification of need by a licensed physician, physician assistant, nurse practitioner, or clinical psychologist.

Maggie L. Walker Governor's School will award credit for the work when it is done under the supervision of a licensed teacher, a person eligible to hold a Virginia license, or other appropriately licensed professional employed by the divisions, and there is evidence that the instructional time requirements or alternative means of awarding credit adopted by the Regional School Board have been met.
