STAFF HEALTH

As a condition of employment every new employee of the Regional School Board shall submit a certificate signed by a licensed physician, physician assistant, nurse practitioner or registered nurse stating the employee appears free of communicable tuberculosis. Volunteers and/or contract employees, including cafeteria workers and custodians may be required to provide such a certificate.

After consulting with the local health director, the Regional School Board may require the submission of such certificates annually, or at such intervals as it deems appropriate, as a condition to continued employment.

Physical Exams for School Bus Drivers

No person shall be employed as a bus driver unless he or she has a physical exam of the scope required by the Board of Education and provides the Regional School Board the results of the exam on the form prescribed by the Board of Education. Such exam and report may be provided by a licensed nurse practitioner or physician assistant.

The Regional School Board may also require alcohol and drug testing in accordance with Policy 5007.4- School Bus Drivers.
