

## STUDENT ORGANIZATION APPROVAL

Regular activities allow for growth and understanding in the areas of special interest. Student organizations, clubs and activities are subject to student interest and will change based upon student interest.

Students interested in starting a new organization or club will contact the Activities Director for sample constitution, bylaws and application instruction. Consideration of new organizations or clubs will only be deliberated from the first day of August through the last day of September each academic year.

Student organizations must be sponsored by one or more faculty members. Sponsorship is considered in the vetting process.

With completion of all application materials the new organization or club will be vetted by the Activities Director, who will make recommendation for approval or denial to the Maggie L. Walker Governor's School Administration for their determination.

The decision of the Maggie L. Walker Governor's School Administration in this matter is final. Organizations or clubs are not recognized as valid activities until approval is obtained.

Upon Maggie L. Walker Governor's School Administrative approval, club materials will be provided to the Regional School Board for their information.
