

SUMMER ASSIGNMENTS FOR AP SPANISH LANGUAGE AND CULTURE

1. ¡Bienvenidos a la clase de AP-Idioma Español y Cultura! The following instructions will be written in English so that parents can assist in the preparations as well.
2. There will be no Early AP Sessions for AP Spanish Language and Culture in Aug./Sept., 2016. We will begin our course together on the first day of school, Tuesday, Sept. 6, 2016.
3. Our goal in this rigorous class is to achieve proficiency in the language/culture and to attain a high level of success on the AP Exam. Therefore, it is highly recommended that students complete the following assignments on the DUE DATES, so as to review basic concepts prior to the class instruction in September. These assignments are not intended to consume all of your summer hours, but will greatly facilitate your comprehension when class begins, as they review your previous levels of study and help to regain the base needed for success. Again, of course, enjoy your summer and the needed break from school!
4. All students enrolled in this course will receive the summer assignments in class during the week of June 6-10, 2016.
5. Assignment instructions: (can be completed in varying order):
  - A. UNA VEZ MÁS WKBK.: pages 1-95: These pages should be completed/reviewed/mastered before the school year begins in September. All exercises need to be completed with answers checked AFTER exercises are done, and ALL new vocabulary expressions on each page need to be highlighted and defined in English.  
DUE DATE: FIRST WEEK OF CLASS IN SEPTEMBER.
  - B. QUIZLET HORIZONTES VOCABULARY LISTS—CAPÍTULOS 1-10: Study/review/ all 10 chapters of vocabulary expressions in preparation for the AP Spanish Language and Culture Exam.  
DUE DATE: FIRST WEEK OF CLASS IN SEPTEMBER.
  - C. TRIÁNGULO APROBADO WKBK.: pages I-XVI—read/study/become familiar with the format of the workbook, the types of exercises, the 6 principal themes of this AP Exam (with their corresponding sub-themes as well), and highlight important ideas/hints/clues. Also, study and review the first main theme, Los desafíos mundiales, pages 1-50. It is not necessary to do the exercises yet, but simply read over the various parts and pay special attention to the sections labeled...Cápsula cultural/Comparaciones (a suggestion here would be to go ahead and research the questions and take note of some examples that will facilitate comprehension as we discuss them in class in the coming school year).  
DUE DATE: SEPTEMBER 26, 2016.
