

SUMMER ASSIGNMENTS FOR AP SPANISH LANGUAGE AND CULTURE

1. ¡Bienvenidos a la clase de AP-Idioma Español y Cultura! The following instructions will be written in English so that parents can assist in the preparations as well.
2. There will be no Early AP Sessions for AP Spanish Language and Culture in Aug./Sept., 2018. We will begin our course together on the first day of school, Tuesday, Sept. 4, 2018.
3. Our goal in this rigorous class is to achieve proficiency in the language/culture and to attain a high level of success on the AP Exam. Therefore, it is highly recommended that students complete the following assignments on the DUE DATES, so as to review basic concepts prior to the class instruction in September. These assignments are not intended to consume all of your summer hours, but will greatly facilitate your comprehension when class begins, as they review your previous levels of study and help to regain the base needed for success. Again, of course, enjoy your summer and the needed break from school!
4. All students enrolled in this course will receive the summer assignments in class during the week of June 4-8, 2018.
5. Assignment instructions: (can be completed in varying order):
 - A. UNA VEZ MÁS WKBK.: pages 1-95: These pages should be completed/reviewed/mastered before the school year begins in September. All exercises need to be completed with answers checked AFTER exercises are done, and ALL new vocabulary expressions on each page need to be highlighted and defined in English. Note: These pages most likely were completed in the Pre-AP course, so a good review of this information is what is needed before our AP class begins.
DUE DATES: TEST #1 ON PAGES 1-25 WILL BE THE THURSDAY AND FRIDAY OF THE FIRST WEEK OF SCHOOL. THE OTHER PAGES WILL BE ASSESSED AT DIFFERENT TIMES DURING THE COURSE OF THE FIRST SEMESTER.
 - B. QUIZLET HORIZONTES VOCABULARY LISTS 1-10: Study/review all 10 chapters of vocabulary expressions in preparation for the AP Spanish Language and Culture Exam.
DUE DATE: SIMPLY BE PREPARED TO INCORPORATE MANY OF THESE VOCABULARY EXPRESSIONS INTO ESSAYS AND ORAL PROFICIENCY WORK THROUGHOUT THE COURSE OF THE YEAR'S WORK IN AP. THE MORE FAMILIAR YOU ARE WITH THESE EXPRESSIONS BEFORE TAKING THE AP EXAM IN MAY, THE BETTER YOU WILL BE PREPARED TO EXPERIENCE SUCCESS ON THIS COMMUNICATIVE TYPE OF ASSESSMENT.
