

FUNDRAISING AND SOLICITATION

All fund-raising activities conducted by school sponsored groups for the benefit of Maggie L. Walker Governor's School must provide an educational benefit to students and must not interfere with the instructional program. All fund-raising activities conducted by school-sponsored organizations or clubs must be approved in advance by the director or his/her designee. Fund-raising refers to the raising of non-appropriated funds by students, parents, or others for the educational benefit of students and this school.

Students may participate in fund-raising activities provided such activities are approved in writing and carefully monitored and regulated by the school director or his/her designee. Students are not excused from class to participate in fund-raising activities. No grade is affected by a student's participation, or lack of participation, in a fund-raising activity.

The faculty or staff activity sponsor is responsible for being present during fund-raising activities unless otherwise approved by the director or his/her designee; and collecting, depositing monies produced into the appropriate activity fund by the next business day following the activity.

The activities director develops and maintains a list of all approved fund-raising activities and reports all activities to the director.

The director periodically furnishes the Regional School Board with an up-to-date listing of all fundraising activities being conducted in the school.
