Approval of Minutes and Agenda

New Business

- <u>Calendar</u> Max reported this committee met once last month and looked at the first semester. They will next begin looking at the second semester next and drafting an early start and standard start.
- Nominations and by-laws Karen T. will lead this committee, with Leigh Anne and Rachel G. as additional members.
- <u>Campus life during COVID</u> Gabriella reported that Campus life has met 5 times. They started with a survey of students to gather comfort level. Drive-in movie has been planned. Yoga and chalk day coming up. The PTSA partnered with SAC on resources
- <u>MLWGS strategic marketing plan</u> Virginia reported on behalf of the committee, which met 3 weeks ago. They will be focused on capturing materials for creating a video to share with 6th graders about the school. Dr Ellis is engaged in a similar effort to prepare a video for 6th graders. Karen S. mentioned that the drama group is working on a play that could be used for video material.
- <u>Prospective students /early engagement</u> Ed reported that the committee has not met yet and may initially coordinate efforts with the marketing group to align with their plan. Karen S. suggested targeting certain groups of elementary teams (i.e., Lego Robotics). Crista mentioned that there used to be a science day for middle school kids. Leigh Anne mentioned model UN. Ed

suggested Chess club. Michael suggested piloting something with an underrepresented middle school, possibly Carver which is close by.

- <u>Removing structural barriers to student engagement</u> (written report from Rachel L) We have met twice, and we have decided to develop a survey to gather student feedback and input on how we might be able to make changes to school climate when the school reopens in February. While resources such as transportation maybe part of what comes up, the goal is to get more at the heart of why students from underrepresented backgrounds feel disengaged, less connected to the school, and perhaps less inclined to participate in school activities. Developing a survey of this nature is an important task, and we are hoping to develop a focus group of seniors to help us craft the questions. I am working with Gabriella to craft an invitation email for the focus group (she is currently awaiting my email draft), and we hope to meet with these students next week. Our goal would be to launch the survey between Thanksgiving and winter break, then provide recommendations to Dr. Lowerre based on the survey data in January.
- <u>SAC marketing and communications plan</u> Karen T., Denise, Ed, and Michael will be meeting soon to discuss SAC's website presence. Karen T. attends PTSA meeting and offered to solicit resources from PTSA volunteer rosters for any committee wanting outside participants. Karen S. asked about if there is any mention of outside participation in SAC's bylaws. The bylaws committee will investigate.
