Mr. Kenneth Pritchett

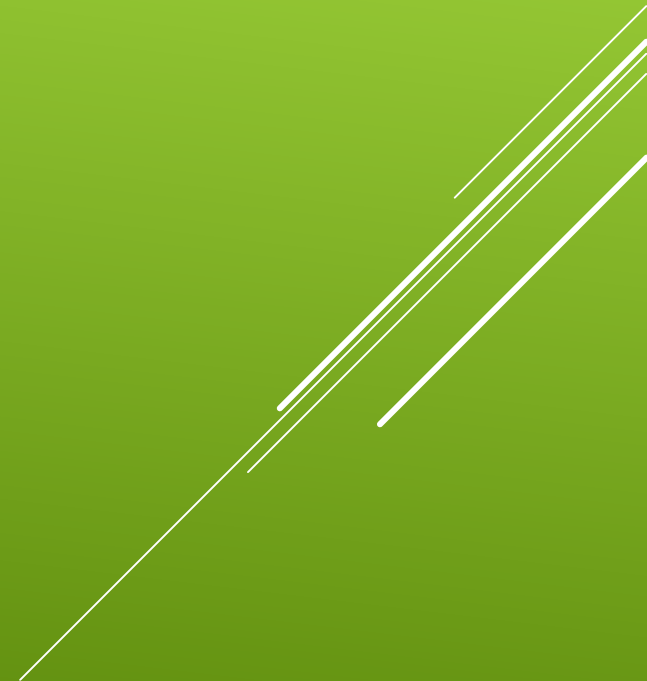

BOARD: Ms. Valarie Ayers

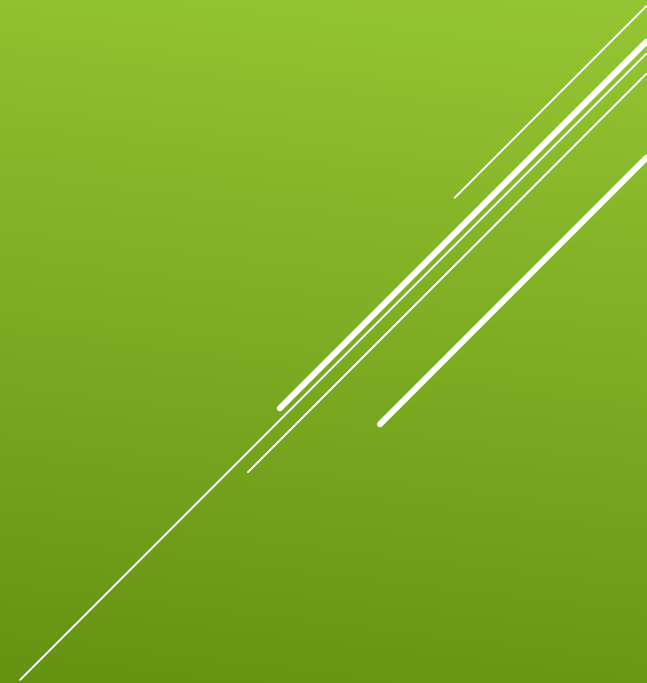
