APPLICATION 2022



Applications are accepted from students during their eighth-grade year of school. A student may only apply once. To be considered for admission, applicants must complete the admissions process according to the timeline established by the regional Planning Committee and published in the Admissions Handbook.

The parent/guardian of a student must have a primary established residence (where the student physically resides) in a participating school division for the student to apply and be granted admission to Maggie L. Walker Governor's School for Government and International Studies. Students will only be accepted through a participating school division and only on a full-time basis.

Application Instructions

The Admissions Handbook which accompanies this application gives detailed and specific information about the admissions process for 2022. For divisions using paper, carefully separate and process the following parts of this application packet:

The application. Complete and submit the application page to your local public middle / junior high school counselor no later than December 1, 2021. (On-line portal deadline for Chesterfield, Henrico, Richmond) Applications will not be accepted after this date.

Recommendation A. (Only one may be submitted.) Fill out the top of Recommendation A and give it to a seventh or eighth grade English, math, science, social studies or world language teacher who agrees to give you a reference. That person is to submit Recommendation A to your local public middle / junior high school counselor no later than December 1, 2021.

Recommendation B. (Only one may be submitted.) Fill out the top of Recommendation B and give it to a teacher or other adult, not a relative, who knows your potential for success and agrees to give you a reference. That person is to submit Recommendation B to your local public middle / junior high school counselor no later than December 1, 2021.

Private and home-schooled students. For private school and home-schooled students, submission of the application varies by school division. Please refer to the Governor's School website (www.mlwgs.com) for this information. Students who have been home-schooled must have their curriculum on file and approved by the local public-school division.

Residency Guidelines for Admissions

The parent/guardian of a student must have an established primary residence (where the student physically resides) in a participating school division for the student to apply and be granted admission to Maggie L. Walker Governor's School for Government and International Studies. [Hereafter, the student's residence refers to the primary residence of the parent/guardian(s).]

The school division where the student resides on March 1 will be responsible for tuition for the school year beginning in the fall of the same year. Parents will be responsible for officially notifying, in writing, the school division and MLWGS within ten (10) school days of change of residency. Failure to notify MLWGS and the school division may result in the loss of enrollment and the loss of tuition payment by the school division. (Admissions Handbook, p.18)

Students who are residents of a participating school division may apply only during the fall of their eighth-grade year.

Students who establish primary residence in a participating school division during the second semester of eighth grade may apply and be tested during the summer. The application is due prior to testing which will take place at MLWGS in July. (Handbook, p.18) Following testing the applicant will be placed on the waiting list of the local participating school division of residence based on the regional evaluation. New residents during the first semester may apply and be evaluated on the regular schedule.

Applicants who change residence from one participating division to another after the December deadline, but before March 1, will be transferred to the new division applicant pool for acceptance status consideration. Students selected for the wait list for a division who move to another division will be transferred to the new division and reevaluated for wait list status.

If a student wishes to apply and is enrolled in a public school based on an established primary residence in a participating school division, the student must apply for admission only through that school division.

If a student wishes to apply and is not enrolled in a school based on residency, the student must apply through the participating publicschool division of residence. Documentation giving proof of the student's residence is required. Documentation giving proof of "residential custody" must be provided by the parent or guardian with whom the student resides if other parent/guardian(s) reside elsewhere.

Once accepted and enrolled, a student may remain at MLWGS <u>only</u> if the student maintains primary residence in a participating school division.
