VIRTUAL COURSES

Students may enroll in and receive a standard verified unit of credit for supervised virtual courses with the prior approval of the director. The director is responsible for developing regulations governing this method of delivery of instruction that include the provisions of 8 VAC 20-131-110 and the administration of the required Standards of Learning test prescribed by 8 VAC 20-131-30. For courses offered for possible high school credits, standard units of credit are awarded for successful completion of such courses when the course is the equivalent to that offered in the school program and the work is done under the supervision of a licensed teacher qualified in the relevant subject areas. A verified unit of credit may be earned when the student has successfully completed the requirements specified in 8 VAC 20-131-110.

A student who is enrolled in Maggie L. Walker Governor's School will not be charged tuition for enrolling in any virtual program offered by the school.
