REGIONAL SCHOOL BOARD ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING

The Maggie L. Walker Governor's School Regional Board holds an organizational meeting annually.

At that meeting the Board

- establishes its regular meeting schedule for the following year,
- elects one of its members as chair,
- approves a designee of the director to attend meetings of the Regional School Board in case of the director's absence or inability to attend, and
- appoints, on the recommendation of the director, a clerk of the Regional School Board.

Upon election, the chair immediately assumes office and presides over the remainder of the meeting.

In addition, the Regional School Board

- may elect one of its members as vice-chair and
- may appoint a deputy clerk.

The vice-chair and deputy clerk, if any, are empowered to act in all matters in case of the absence or inability to act of the chair or clerk, respectively, or as otherwise provided by the Regional School Board.

The terms of the chair, clerk, vice-chair, and deputy clerk are one year.

The Regional School Board's annual organizational meeting is held in January.
