

ADMISSION OF INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

This policy clearly outlines the admission of international students to the Maggie L. Walker Governor's School for Government and International Studies.

International Students will only be accepted to the Maggie L. Walker Governor's School for Government and International Studies on a full-time basis. A full-time student is one actively enrolled and participating in at least 7 of 8 periods per semester.

Procedure:

- a. The definition of an international student is the child of a foreign diplomat/governmental representative or is the child of a foreign employee of an international corporation who will live in a participating district for a defined period of time.
- b. These students will make application through the district where the student resides or will reside.
- c. International students will submit to the same admissions/testing process as local students.

Financial Obligations:

- a. It is expected that international student(s) tuition will be paid by the home district.
