

NAMING SCHOOL FACILITIES

It is the responsibility of the Maggie L. Walker Governor's School Regional Board to determine the name of the school and school facilities. The Regional School Board will use the following procedure when naming or renaming the school or school facility:

The Regional School Board will solicit and accept input from the public regarding the names of the school and school facilities but reserves the right to make the final decision regarding the name of the school or school facility. Suggestions regarding the name of the school or school facility must be in writing, must state the name of the person or group making the suggestion and must state the reasons supporting the suggestion. The Regional School Board may create a committee to make recommendations to the Regional School Board on the naming of the school or school facility.

The school nor any of its school facilities will be named for a living individual. Schools and school facilities may be named for individuals who have been deceased for at least 5 years.

The Regional School Board may rename the school or any of its school facilities upon a determination that it is appropriate to do so.
