GOALS FOR SCHOOL-COMMUNITY RELATIONS

The Regional School Board recognizes that good school-community relations are essential to securing public input and public support for educational programs. The Regional School Board empowers the director to set goals and standards for school-community relations and periodically evaluates the school's relationship with the public. The Regional School Board also regularly evaluates its programs for maintaining open channels of communication and good relations with parents, community organizations, other governmental organizations, non-profit organizations, businesses and industries and the community at large.

Through its school-community relations program, the Regional Board encourages the community to

- take an active interest in the school and participate in school activities,
- place a high priority on education and make funds available for an educational system that supports learning for all children, and
- establish partnerships with the school to enhance learning opportunities.
