SMALL PURCHASING

Pursuant to written procedures not requiring competitive sealed bids or competitive negotiation, the Regional School Board may enter into single or term contracts for goods and services, if the aggregate or the sum of all phases is not expected to exceed \$200,000, other than professional services and nontransportation related construction if the aggregate or the sum of all phases is not expected to exceed \$300,000 and transportation-related construction if the aggregate or sum of all phases is not expected to exceed \$25,000. However, such small purchase procedures shall provide for competition wherever practicable. Such small purchase procedures may allow for single or term contracts for professional services without requiring competitive negotiation, provided the aggregate or the sum of all phases is not expected to exceed \$80,000. Where small purchase procedures are adopted for construction, the procedures shall not waive compliance with the Uniform State Building Code.
