

VOTING METHOD

Each Regional School Board member’s vote on every decision is recorded in the minutes of the meeting. The minutes of the meeting also reflect the method and result of all votes. No votes are taken by secret or written ballot.

In any case, in which there is a tie vote of the Regional School Board when all members are not present, the question shall be passed by until the next meeting when it will again be voted upon even though all members are not present. In any case, in which there is a tie vote on any question after complying with this procedure or in any case in which there is a tie vote when all the members of the Regional School Board are present, the clerk records the vote and immediately notifies the tie breaker, if any, to vote as provided in the Code of Virginia § 22.1-75. If no tie-breaker has been appointed or elected as authorized by state law, any tie vote defeats the motion, resolution or issue voted upon.
