BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS MANAGEMENT AND MAINTENANCE

The director has the general responsibility for the care, custody, and safekeeping of all school property. The director is responsible for the operation, supervision, care, and maintenance of the school plant.

The school maintains records of regular safety, health, and fire inspections that have been conducted and certified by local health and fire departments. The frequency of such inspections is determined by the Regional School Board in consultation with the local health and fire departments. In addition, the school administration equips all exit doors with panic hardware as required by the Uniform Statewide Building Code.

The school maintains documentation of any pesticide application that includes the target pest, the formulation applied, and the specific location of the application.
