

FACILITIES PLANNING

The Maggie L. Walker Governors' School Regional Board is responsible for the regular operation and orderly development provides for the erecting, furnishing, equipping, and maintenance of all school facilities. The Regional School Board concerns itself with both short and long-range planning.

The executive director presents to the Regional School Board annually, or as necessary to coordinate with the planning process of the appropriating body, a Capital Improvement Program which includes recommendations regarding timing, location, costs, and savings associated with: new building requirements; and restoration and renewal of existing school facilities

The executive director may make recommendations for new buildings and renovations after receiving input concerning facility utilization, development, and closure from a broad-based committee representing the staff and the community.

Recommendations are supported by data that supports the feasibility and need for construction and/or renovation.
