

ADVANCED PLACEMENT AND DUAL ENROLLMENT CLASSES

Students and their parents are notified of the availability of dual enrollment and advanced placement classes and the College and Career Ready Virginia Program; the qualifications for enrolling in such classes, and the availability of financial assistance to low-income and needy students to take the advanced placement examinations and to enroll in dual enrollment classes. Students and their parents are also notified of the program with a community college to enable students to complete an associate's degree, a one-year Uniform Certificate of General Studies, or the Passport Program concurrent with a high school diploma. The executive director promulgates regulations to implement this policy, which ensure the provision of timely and adequate notice to students and their parents.
