

COMMUNITY USE OF SCHOOL FACILITIES

The Maggie L. Walker Governor's School Regional Board may permit use of school property by members of the community when such use will not impair the efficiency of the school. The executive director shall develop guidelines and applications for the use of school property. Requests for the use of any school facilities shall be made to the executive director or the executive director's designee. The executive director shall report any actions taken under this policy at regular meetings of the Regional School Board.

Employees are prohibited from utilizing school property for personal use or gain.

If the Regional School Board permits the use of its facilities by members of the community or the distribution of literature on school property or at school functions, it will permit such use or such distribution by the Boy Scouts of America, the Girl Scouts of the United States of America, and other youth groups designated as patriotic societies by federal law, to the same extent and in the same manner as all other persons or groups.
