

TEACHING ABOUT DRUGS, ALCOHOL AND TOBACCO

The Maggie L. Walker Governor’s School Regional Board provides instruction concerning

- drugs and drug abuse,
- the public safety hazards and dangers of alcohol abuse, underage drinking, underage marijuana use, and drunk driving,
- the health and safety risks of using tobacco products, nicotine vapor products, alternative nicotine products, and
- gambling and the addictive potential thereof.

Instruction on Opioid Overdose Prevention and Reversal in Secondary School

The Regional School Board provides a program of instruction on opioid overdose prevention and reversal in the school, which includes instruction in identifying the signs of possible opioid overdose and training in the administration of an opioid antagonist for the reversal of a potentially life-threatening opioid overdose. The Regional School Board determines the appropriate grade level to provide such program in grades nine through 12.
