

STAFF WEAPONS IN SCHOOL

No one may possess or use any firearm or any weapon, as defined in Policy 8033 Weapons in School, on school property (including school vehicles), on that portion of any property open to the public and then exclusively used for school-sponsored functions or extracurricular activities while such functions or activities are taking place at a school sponsored activity, or on any school bus without authorization of the executive director or the executive director’s designee. The executive director or the executive director’s designee is permitted to give authority to possess a firearm on school property only to persons expressly authorized by statute to possess a firearm on school property.

Violation of this policy by an employee will result in appropriate personnel action up to and including dismissal.

Illegal conduct will be reported to law enforcement officials.
