If you'd like to sit for more than the free senior portrait, please visit Lifetouch/Prestige at **prestigeportraits.com/studio**. If you have trouble signing up, **please contact Prestige Customer Care at 1-800-736-4753**. If you'd rather get your formal Yearbook portrait at another studio, your portraits must adhere to the following specifications:

- formal dress (tux or drapè)
- “midnight blue” or other standard, dark blue or black background
- photo should be head & shoulders, w/ bottom of frame hitting mid-chest level.

3. Senior Ads

- Yearbook pages measure 8-1/2" by 11". Ads can be a **full page (\$240), 1/2-page (\$150), or 1/4-page (\$90)**.
- Please make checks payable to MLWGS. **We cannot accept electronic payment.**
- Send **picture(s)**, along with any **text** you'd like to include, to Mr. White's attention, at MLWGS. Your child's name will be inserted in the ad, as a kind of headline, but you may include a message, as well.

- **PLEASE NOTE:** Digital files must be a minimum of 300 dpi. We can't accept digital layouts that you've done yourself, as they tend to yield low-quality and hard-to-manipulate results.
- **PLEASE NOTE: Please send FULL-SIZE digital images. Please DO NOT send screenshots or thumbnails.** Any digital images should, ideally, be 300 KB or larger.

- If you send prints, keep them loose. Don't use tape or staples. We'll return your photos in the spring.
- **DO NOT cut-and-paste pictures onto a sheet of paper;** the results will not be of optimal quality.
- **DO NOT crop the pictures yourself,** either manually or digitally. Send us the print or **full-size digital image,** and we'll do the cropping for you.
- Want to order an ad? Great! Here's what we need to know:

- What size would you like?
- What is the name of the senior being honored?
- What are your name, address, phone number and email?

- To submit your materials, you may...
 - mail your prints or, if using digital images, a flash drive to Mr. White at MLWGS, or...
 - send digital images to Mr. White at mwhite@gsgis.k12.va.us, or...
 - share them with Mr. White on the Google Shared Drive at [mwhite@gsgis.k12.va.us](https://drive.google.com/drive/u/0/folders/1U8tTjDQFvYXGgR9BzE6eZlHnNkKdL7).
- The Yearbook editors and staff **reserve the right to alter, edit, or exclude photos or text** due to spatial constraints or failure to comply with our guidelines.
- Space is limited, and submissions are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis, with the final **deadline for submissions on Mon, Jan. 12th**. Ads missing the deadline may risk exclusion.
- Please note: **The above deadline is real**. Seniors are NOT guaranteed an ad. **Only payment will hold your space**; sending an email with images or a request for a reservation will NOT hold your space. **Reserve your space with a check.**
